It is with a good deal of regret that I inform you that funding for future "Broadway on Broadway" presentations will no longer be available from the Music Performance Fund.

This Fund was one of the original sponsors of the program, as it not only presented the best of the current musical shows, but did so in conformance with our Trust Agreement: LIVE MUSICAL PRESENTATIONS, FREE TO THE PUBLIC, played by professional musicians.

In the latest 2005 program a significant portion was prerecorded music, which not only flies in the face of our funding mandate, but also is a complete breach of the understanding and relationship we have enjoyed over the past fourteen years.

I do not purport to determine the future of musical theatre, but if it's with canned music it will be without our participation.
